



Westwood Board of Health Sharps Collection Program

Needles, lancets, and syringes are all considered sharps.

Sharps must be placed only in this approved container for proper disposal.

Westwood residents may obtain approved sharps containers **FREE** of charge during business hours at the Board of Health Office, Town Hall, or at the Senior Center.



Tape lid securely closed and place containers, one at a time in the Sharps Collection Kiosk located at the **Police Station on High Street – new location!!**

Please note that the kiosk previously located at the Islington Fire Station has been removed.

PLEASE DO NOT put any other type of container into Kiosk. Using containers which are too large causes the Kiosk to malfunction and jeopardizes the sharps collection program.
