Heating and cooling with Ductless Mini-splits or geothermal heat pumps can save even more.

Up to eight solar companies that have completed solar installations in Westwood and have received high ratings are being invited to explain the options for installing solar PV, including:

- types of solar panels,
- types of contracts,
- length and steps of the process from evaluation to connection,
- rebates and tax incentives
