NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The WESTWOOD HISTORICAL COMMISSION will hold a public hearing on *Wednesday, March 24, 2020 at 7:30 PM* at the Fisher School, 830 High Street, Westwood, Massachusetts 02090, regarding an application filed by Dmitry Deych requesting permission to demolish a single family residence, which may be historically and/or architecturally significant. The structure is located at 229 High Street. The Historical Commission's review will be conducted pursuant to Westwood General Bylaw Chapter 250A.

The property is located in the Single Residence E (SRE) zoning district and shown on the Assessor's Map as MAP 05, Lot 38. The single-family residence located at 229 High Street, is believed to have been constructed in 1850.
